WHEREAS, § 12-43.3-103(2)(a), C.R.S., enacted by House Bill 10-1284 and effective July 1, 2010, provides that a county may adopt and enforce a resolution prohibiting the cultivation or sale of medical marijuana; and

WHEREAS, § 12-43.3-106, C.R.S., enacted by House Bill 10-1284 and effective July 1, 2010, establishes a local option allowing a county, by a majority of the members of the governing board for the county, to vote to prohibit the operation of medical marijuana centers, optional premises cultivation operations, and medical marijuana-infused products manufacturers' licenses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners hereby finds and declares that it is necessary to the preservation and furtherance of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Jefferson County to prohibit the operation of medical marijuana centers, optional premises cultivation operations, and medical marijuana-infused products manufacturers within unincorporated Jefferson County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to the authority granted in § 12-43.3-103(2)(a), C.R.S., and § 12-43.3-106, C.R.S., the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson prohibits the operation of medical marijuana centers, optional premises cultivation operations, and medical marijuana-infused products manufacturers within unincorporated Jefferson County.
