



**SB-09-232
Implementation**

Purpose

- \$17 million to assist local government communities most directly and substantially impacted by production of energy resources on Federal Mineral Lease (FML) land.

Priority

- Grant applications up to \$17 million that:
 - Submitted jointly by multiple local governments; or
 - Seek funding for a project that is a multi-jurisdictional project or that requires a substantial amount of funding.

Process Assumptions

1. Pre-application and selection.
2. Selected pre-applications to submit full application.
3. Minimum of at least two local governments.
4. Minimum 25% match which can come from cash, gift, grant or loan
5. Enforceable Intergovernmental agreements part of full application.
6. Maximum four-year construction completion time frame.
7. No supplemental funding for Tier III projects.
8. No Tier I or II applications to support a Tier III.



SB-09-232 Tier III Timing and Schedule

- **July 1** formal notification of local governments SB-09-232 Tier III pilot available with \$17 million.
- **August 3rd** letter of interest due.
- **Regional Managers** provide technical assistance to local governments who submitted letter of interest.
- **October 2nd** two page pre-applications due.
- **November 10th** staff review and summary report submitted by Regional Managers.
- **November 20th** Energy Impact Advisory Committee reviews pre-applications and provide recommendation to Executive Director.
- **December 1st** Executive director announces which local governments will be allowed to submit a full application.
- **February 9th** full applications are due.
- **March 2nd** staff review and project summary report submitted.
- **March 19th** Tier III Hearing with Impact Advisory Committee and recommendations to Executive Director.
- **April 1st** Executive Director announces Tier III awards.
